Portable Ankle Brachial Index Screening Kit for PAD

The ABI is an easy, noninvasive exam for peripheral arterial disease (PAD) screening. This exam is recommended by the American Heart Association, the American Diabetes Association and the American College of Cardiology for patients at risk of PAD.

The Portable ABI Kit has all of the instruments and accessories needed to perform an Ankle Brachial Index (ABI) in a convenient carrying case, including a means of documentation for billing purposes. This is ideal for clinics doing ABI screening, home health, physician's offices, hospitals that want to perform screening at the bedside and other places where portability is needed.

The Portable ABI Kit includes:

- MD6 Doppler: Detects peripheral bloodflow in the ankle and arm.
- MD6VR Chart Recorder: Prints real-time Doppler wave-forms from the MD6.
- Four Straight Segmental Blood Pressure Cuffs: One cuff for each arm and one for each ankle.
- S300 Aneroid Sphygmomanometer: Rugged cuff inflator with a trigger release for controlled cuff bleed rate.
- Custom Carrying Case: Transport and store the Portable ABI Kit.
